

Course of Action

Our name has been changed to COPP, LLC (formerly CDOPP) so it does not reflect that the group only consists of deeded owners. We are looking for a remedy for both ownership groups as a collective group of vacation owners. Our membership has been growing rapidly.

The initial goal of this group was to obtain the membership list consisting of contact information for all of the owners of the Point at Poipu in order to have a direct line of communication with other owners.

The water intrusion assessment notice (or lack of notice for some) has increased the awareness of our members that their vacation destination is in jeopardy. You have received this update because you have joined a group that has successfully brought a great number of owners forward to work together so we can protect our resort.

The immediate goals of COPP, LLC going forward consist of the following:

1. Obtain a Temporary Restraining Order or a Court Injunction to halt all collection and foreclosure threats and activities.
2. Provide legal counsel with "accurate" and "relevant" information to assist with bringing forth a Class Action suit against Diamond Resorts International and the Board of Directors for our associations.
3. Obtain or view a copy of "every" policy of insurance procured by the Board.
4. Take legal action to secure the release of the membership list to members as stated in several Hawaii Revised Statutes, the laws that govern the State of Hawaii.
5. Get the attention of governmental agencies in the State of Hawaii to intervene.
6. Keep an open line of communication to the members that have registered with us.

We cannot do this without you!

Without a group effort, we do not believe that positive changes will occur to benefit the owners in a manner that we believe is necessary. We have invested a lot of money to have a vacation destination and we need to protect it.

We are a group consisting solely of volunteers. Up to this date, the majority of the expenses have been paid by the board of COPP, LLC. There are minor expenses involved in coordinating and carrying out an effort like this, including (but not inclusive) website hosting, domain name registration, post office boxes, registration fees, and fees associated with forming a legal entity (LLC). COPP, LLC is a non-profit and no salaries are paid to any board or committee members.

The legal expenses that we will incur in taking this type of action is not small, but nowhere near the \$65 million dollar price tag that is being thrown at you.

We have received contributions from some of our members and others have offered more financial help. We need to have enough financial resources to carry out the steps that we believe are necessary to reach a satisfactory resolution.

We are asking our members to contribute \$200 or more per interval week that you own. If you are able to contribute more, it will only strengthen our collective efforts. If you are unable to contribute this amount, please contribute an amount that you feel comfortable with. The funds will be used sensibly and at the discretion of our Board and the committees that are assisting us.

These are the steps that need to be taken immediately and/or have already started;

1. Continue to work with legal counsel so an action is filed prior to December 31, 2011
2. Provide material and information to you to assist in a letter writing campaign
3. Hand-deliver copies of your complaints directly to officials in Hawaii
4. Continue to make contacts with media outlets
5. Obtain the contact information of additional owners
6. Provide communication to owners beyond what the current management company provides and controls
7. Seek assistance from our owners in order to provide an organized effort

We have already started to implement these actions. We expect to incur legal expenses at the end of this month so we can file actions against the assessment that is due January 1, 2012.
